Abingdon Bible Church Property

1953 - 1996

The original church property on West Main Street was first rented and then purchased in 1953. Minutes of a business meeting Nov. 22, 1953 record, "Rev. Woolley described the building and equipment. He stated the price was \$14,500.00 and explained the conditions on which it could be purchased. The vote was cast by ballot. All were in favor of the motion."

In 1980, 7.3 acres of the Millsap farm were purchased at auction for \$27,100.00 on which to build a new church facility. Over the next ten years, plans were drawn up and building funds were collected. Building Committee members were Ted Shanklin (Chairman), Phil Boutwell, Don Boyer, Brenda Crane, James Layne, Noel McMillan, Shirley Taylor and Monty Vernon. The goal of \$150,000.00 in the building fund was met in January 1990. Groundbreaking was held and construction was begun on the 1990 building. The dedication and open house for the new building was held on February 3, 1991. The total cost was \$775,000.00 of which \$300,000.00 was borrowed. The loan was paid off in 1996.

Homeless Care Kits

Homeless care kits are stocked on the shelf above the coat rack in the foyer next to the carport. Each care kit contains at minimum, a toothbrush and toothpaste, socks for warmth, along with some food and a personal note from a student for encouragement.
