### Why There? (Bethlehem)

- I. To Confirm Jesus' Royal Lineage
  - A. Jesus can be the Messiah because he was a descendant of David
  - B. To eliminate any question of this, God arranged circumstances to have Jesus born in Bethlehem
- II. To Fulfill Prophecy (Micah 5:2; Luke 2:4)
  - The prophecy in Micah (5:2) specifies that the Messiah would be born in Bethlehem Ephrathah, not the Bethlehem near Nazareth
